Winenot is playing with words ... «Mauves» turns into the colour mauve, recalling the highlights that this wine sometimes reveals...

Tasting Notes

Deep ruby red in colour, bright, clear and flowing.
The nose is fairly rich with roasted and black fruit notes.
The attack is round and fruity, with just a hint of liquorice.
The finish reveals silky, soft fine grained tannins.
An attractive aromatic length for a wine of great elegance.

Serve at 16°C after leaving briefly to breathe.

Food Pairings

Perfect with a prime cut of beef, or cep mushroom and foie gras ravioles for those with gourmet tastes.
